



ADMISSIONS PROCEDURE

- The child must be age appropriate as stipulated by our school policy (i.e. kindergarten - 2,5 - 3,5 years. Foundation (Pre-Reception) 3,5-4,5 years, Reception 4,5- 5,5 years at the beginning of January.
- All children undergo an academic assessment before being awarded a place at Kopano.
- On application, the following documents must be available: birth certificate, previous school reports and medical cards, parents identity documents, P100.00 non-refundable registration fee.

Founded in 1972 in order to provide an education for the children of BCL Mine employees, Kopano became an Independent private school in 2002

Assessment

Individual and group methods are applied at Kopano. We recognise that whilst formal examinations are an important aspect of schooling, continuous assessment, using a variety of methods for a true indication of the child's performance.

As the end of the Grade Seven year, learners write the Primary School Leavers Examination (PSLE), an examination set by the Ministry of Education of Botswana. They also write the Cambridge Primary Checkpoint in April.

The school believes in the concept of a 'heathy body leading to a healthy mind where sporting and cultural activities balance academics.



Many years on, multi-cultural school caters for approximately 450 learners from kindergarten (2-5 years of age) to Grade 7 (13 year of age). The Ministry of Education of Botswana prescribes our curriculum, but as we are committed to the creation of a stimulating learning environment that assures strong academic results, we extended our learners and equip them with the knowledge and insight essential to cope in schools nearby and abroad. Many of our children attend secondary school across borders, and results have proven the effect of our holistic approach.
