ABOUT REMMOGO

A Special Needs School for pupils aged 3.5 - 12 with learning difficulties, autism, speech, language and communication needs.

At Remmogo, we believe in a holistic approach, we believe that consistency across all environments provide the best outcomes when addressing challenging behaviour.





At Remmogo, your child will learn and grow in a special, child-centred classroom that will meet the goals and objectives of each child's Individualised Education Needs. We offer a welcoming environment that focuses on helping your child learn by:

- Adapting classroom activities to allow the full participation of children with special needs.
- Continued training for staff to understand the needs of children with different learning difficulties, learning disabilities, social and behavioural difficulties.
- Teaching children with special needs in the way they will best respond.
- Providing Educational Activities in a safe indoor and outdoor environment
- Working with families to help their kids develop the learning, social and physical skills necessary to reach their full potential.

WHAT WE OFFER

- We offer support for those with diminished social and communication skills including speech and language impediments.
- We also assist children with learning difficulties and disabilities which often manifests as challenging behaviour.
- We assist children struggling with delays as a result of complex learning disabilities such as autism, which are frequently associated with challenging behaviour.
- If your child falls into any of the above categories and is able to communicate verbally and is independent in personal care, then Remmogo Remedial and Special Educational Needs Centre is the place for your child.

REGISTRATION AND FEES

Fees are payable monthly in advance over 10 months (January to end October). Fees are non-refundable.

Please be advised that all additional services required such as the services of a speech therapist, Occupational Therapists, Educational Psychologists will be at an additional fee.

Fees are charged on a pro-rata basis, from the date of admission, for learners who are admitted during the school year.

Please ensure that you have the following documents ready to be submitted with the application form:

- ➤ A full Psychological Assessment Report (if possible) and Therapy Reports (if any), e.g. Speech Therapy, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy. (Reports not older than 2 years will be accepted).
- ➤ Last School Report
- ➤ A certified copy of your child's Birth Certificate
- > A copy of an updated Inoculation Chart
- > A copy of the Parents' ID documents or passports

THE NEED IN OUR COMMUNITY


In every society there are those who suffer from learning disabilities in various areas of development.

These could be consequences resulting from birthing complications, genetic disorders, and severe illness or environmental factors that have affected processing systems.

It is important that each child who is intellectually challenged receives individualised targeted driven teaching programs, strategies and care in order to progress and develop to their fullest potential. With the correct teaching strategies, it is often surprising to what extent a child can progress.

But without the correct training and environment, the child often becomes introverted and withdrawn and may even regress in their development. It is also important that the parents and extended family receive guidance, advice and support in terms of how to adequately cope with the situation. This can only be provided by those who have in–depth knowledge and experience in this field.
